## Student Inclusive Conferences Coming Soon!

Willoughby is part of the second wave of schools in the District moving to a new reporting format during the second term. Student Inclusive Conferences will replace the report card format used in Term One. We know that student success increases when families have a clear understanding of their child's learning and students are at the centre of the communication process. Parents will meet with their child and the teacher to discuss student learning. Students will share their evidence of learning (items that reflect progress), parents will reflect on the growth they have noticed in their child's learning, teachers will reflect on the student's strengths and next steps, and collaboratively, everyone will set the student's next goal(s). The duration of each conference will be approximately 20-25 minutes. Our school's conference "window" will be from February 23 – March 9. More information will be shared in upcoming newsletters on how to sign up for a conference time on our School Appointments website. A brochure with additional information will be sent home on January 26.
