We are extremely excited about the upcoming school year. On behalf of the staff at Willoughby Elementary, I am happy to welcome previous and new families to the 2024-25 school year!



Thursday, September 5th (8:45 - 2:33)





The map below shows the location of teacher classrooms.




When building class lists, we always take the following criteria into consideration:



- Social compatibility
- Small groups that need to be kept together for instructional purposes
- Leadership style of individual students
- Degree of independence in student work habits
- Integration of special needs students
- Separation of students who do not work well together (if possible)
- Class size and composition

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

PLEASE DO NOT BRING THE SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO SCHOOL DURING THE FIRST WEEK. STUDENTS CAN BRING SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO SCHOOL AS SOON AS THEY HAVE BEEN PLACED IN THEIR PERMANENT CLASSES.

Kindergarten students are asked to pay a \$50 school supply fee at <u>https://www.schoolcashonline.com/</u> Kindergarten families have been provided with student numbers to set up *School Cash Online* accounts included in their *Welcome to K* packages that were mailed out during August. Grade One students can use last year's login. We are asking that all students pay for school supplies online to ensure accuracy and security. If this poses a problem, please contact the school office or your child's classroom teacher. **Please note all school fees will be available for payment online no earlier than Sept 6.**

Once classes are finalized, classroom teachers will send out information regarding classroom systems, communication, and organization.



PARKING

Please help make the parking lot safe for our children. Just a few reminders:

- THE DRIVEWAY IS FOR DROP-OFF ONLY NO PARKING IS ALLOWED OUT FRONT OF OUR SCHOOL – Our school entry is one-way. CHILDREN SHOULD EXIT VEHICLES QUICKLY AND SAFELY
- Do not double park cars
- Do not park where yellow lines are painted or on crosswalks
- If you need to park, please park in the church parking lot across from the school and walk your child over to the school at the traffic light – DO NOT JAYWALK
- Always drive slowly
- Please do not park in the bus drop off zone. These are designated for buses only
- Do not park in the driving lane (right lane) on 80th Avenue



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 Please do NOT block the bus stop on 208 Street – There is no parking allowed before or after the bus stop. RCMP, Bylaw and Traffic Police will enforce traffic rules and issue tickets.
