Dogs on School Premisses

At Willoughby Elementary, we prioritize the safety and well-being of all our community members.

While many of us, including our staff and most of our community, love dogs, we recognize that some individuals experience

significant anxiety around them. It can be stressful for these members to encounter dogs, even friendly ones, near classroom doors during drop-off and pick-up times. Additionally, there have been instances where students, in their excitement, have unintentionally stressed dogs on school grounds, leading to negative interactions for both the children and the dogs.

To ensure a safe and comfortable environment for everyone, we kindly ask that if you bring your dog to school, you wait well away from the building. For parents without dogs, please remind your children to always ask the owner's permission before petting any dog, whether familiar or not, especially in new situations.

By working together, we can create a safe, stress-free environment for all members of our community, both human and canine.

Just a reminder that we go outside for recess rain or shine unless the conditions are truly awful. We will keep the students inside the school building if we have a very bad rainstorm outside or temperatures are below -15 C. Please make sure that your children are dressed for the weather. Warm coats, warm or waterproof boots (or both), toques, and gloves. Very important, make sure your children's items are clearly marked. All of these make outside playtimes fun. And we all know recess makes kids learn better, feel better, and get along better.





Information About School Status During Inclement Weather

Snow closures and power outages are an annual occurrence in the Langley School District. So, where do you go to get information about the status of schools during periods of inclement weather? If you are able to access the internet via computer or smartphone, current information about Langley schools can be accessed on all school websites or <u>www.sd35.bc.ca</u>. Updates are also posted to X (formerly Twitter) @LangleySchools and Facebook at <u>www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict</u>. If you don't have internet connectivity but your phone is working, call a relative or friend in an area that has not been affected by the storm and ask them to check the district website for you. Local radio stations are also informed of school status in Langley. Tune in to CKWX 1130AM, CKNW 980AM, Country Radio 107.1FM, Pulse 107.7 or CBC 690AM or 88.1FM for updates.

Please note that Langley District schools are all considered 'open' until a decision to close is required. Decisions on school closures are usually made by 6:30am. As always, it is a parent's decision whether to send their child to school based on safety and individual circumstances. If you feel it is unsafe for you or your child to travel to or attend an open school for any reason, please keep your child home and report an absence to the school.
